However, we want to emphasize that our pediatric providers are strongly pro-vaccination, particularly in light of the recent measles outbreak in Texas, which has disproportionately affected unvaccinated children.

The protection and well-being of all children are our top priorities, and we believe that vaccinations are a critical part of ensuring their health and safety. For this reason, we follow the guidelines set by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and the American Academy of Pediatrics (AAP) when it comes to immunizations.

If you choose not to follow these recommendations for vaccinations, we ask that you sign the vaccine refusal form from Immunize.org. This form is designed to document both our practice's policy on vaccinations and the education we provide to families about the importance of vaccines.

Please understand that if you choose not to sign the refusal form, we will unfortunately have to dismiss your family from our practice. This decision is made with the utmost concern for the health of all our patients.
